BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed August 18, 2021, Sebastian Moving Omaha, LLC ("Applicant" or "Sebastian Moving"), Omaha, Nebraska, seeks authority to operate as a Household Goods Mover pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. § 75-304.03. Applicant is a Nebraska Limited Liability Company with its principal place of business in Omaha. The proposed license would authorize Applicant to provide household goods moving services in Nebraska intrastate commerce between all points in Nebraska over irregular routes.

O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

On August 6, 2020, LB 461 was signed into law, requiring those wishing to provide intrastate household goods moving services in Nebraska to apply for a license from the Commission. Household goods movers would no longer be considered common or contract carriers. On May 25, 2021, the Commission entered an order prescribing the process for certificated household goods movers to transition to licensees and outlining a process for future applications.¹ Applicant's application for authority was not filed until after the May 25, 2021 order.

Those wishing to apply for a license to provide household goods moving services must file an application package that includes the following:

a) Applicant's principal business address in Nebraska;

- b) Applicant's list of vehicles proposed to be used in Nebraska intrastate moves;
- c) Applicant's proposed rates and charges;
- d) A Form E liability certificate of insurance, and Form H cargo certificate of insurance; and
- e) A fingerprint-based background check report.

Applicant filed all necessary documentation to complete its application. Commission staff have reviewed the application package and recommend that the application be approved.

Upon due consideration of the application, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the Application should be granted and that Sebastian Moving Omaha, LLC should be granted a license to provide household goods mover services effective March 15, 2022. The license is valid for one year and may be renewed annually. Sebastian Moving Omaha, LLC, must renew its license as prescribed by Neb. Rev. Stat. § 75-304.03 and Commission rules prior to the license expiration to avoid a lapse in service.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. ML-54 be, and is hereby, granted.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the license granted to Sebastian Moving Omaha, LLC is valid for one year and must be renewed pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. § 75-304.03 and Commission Rule.
