## O P I N I O N     A N D     F I N D I N G S

On February 9, 2022, Doc Holiday Express Company, d/b/a Holiday Express ("Applicant"), Grand Island, Nebraska, filed an application seeking to extend its authority as a common carrier in Nebraska intrastate commerce by adding the transportation of passengers in limousine and special party service between all points in Nebraska over irregular routes, and removing restrictions on its charter service. HHS Designation is no. Notice of the Application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on February 16, 2022. On February 17, 2022 a timely protest was filed by VIP Limousine, LLC. On March 16, 2022 a timely protest was filed by Comstock Corporation d/b/a Action Cab.

After due consideration, I find that the protests filed by VIP Limousine, LLC and Comstock Corporation d/b/a Action Cab should be granted.


