On January 31, 2022, Jackrabbit Transportation, LLC, d/b/a The Dapper Van ("Applicant"), Saint Paul, Nebraska, filed an application seeking authority as a common carrier in Nebraska intrastate commerce in the transportation of passengers by van and bus in charter service between points in Adams, Antelope, Boone, Buffalo, Clay, Custer, Dawson, Garfield, Greeley, Hall, Hamilton, Holt, Howard, Kearney, Loup, Madison, Merrick, Nance, Phelps, Platte, Polk, Sherman, Valley, Wheeler, and York counties, and between said counties, over irregular routes. 
