#### BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed February 7, 2022, @ Your Service, LLC ("Applicant"), Des Moines, Iowa, seeks authority to operate as a contract carrier in Nebraska intrastate commerce as follows:

#### AUTHORITY SOUGHT

CONTRACT: Transportation of passengers by sedan and van in open class service between all points in Nebraska over irregular routes pursuant to its contract with Access 2 Care. HHS Designation: No.

Notice of the application was published in <a href="The Daily Record">The Daily Record</a>, Omaha, Nebraska on February 16, 2022. Because no protests were filed, Application No. B-2028 was processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

## OPINION AND FINDINGS

Applicant is a Iowa Limited Liability Company with its principal place of business in Ankeny, Iowa. Applicant will provide transportation by sedan and van in open class service between all points in Nebraska over irregular routes pursuant to its contract with Access 2 Care. Applicant will begin providing services with five vehicles.

After due consideration of the evidence and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission is of the opinion and finds:

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- 1. The proposed contract carrier operation is consistent with the public interest.
- 2. The application should be granted to the following extent:

## PERMIT AUTHORIZED

SERVICE AND TERRITORY AUTHORIZED:

CONTRACT: Transportation of passengers by sedan and van in open class service between all points in Nebraska over irregular routes pursuant to its contract with Access 2 Care. HHS Designation: No.

## ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. B-2028 be, and it is hereby, granted; and that upon compliance with the terms and conditions set forth in this Order, a Permit of Authority shall be issued to @ Your Service, LLC, Des Moines, Iowa, in Application B-2028 authorizing the operations set forth in the foregoing findings.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Applicant shall not be issued the Permit of Authority authorized by the Commission unless and until, within 45 days from the effective date of this Order, with Neb. Rev. Stat. §§ 75-305 (fees), 75-307 (insurance), and 75-308 (rates) (Cum. Supp 2020), and with the rules and regulations of the Commission, and if upon expiration of such time Applicant has not complied with such terms and conditions, this Order shall, after reasonable notice to Applicant, be of no further force and effect.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Applicant shall not conduct operations until a Permit of Authority is issued.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the operations authorized herein shall be subject to the terms, conditions, and limitations which have been, or may hereafter be prescribed by the Commission.
