## O P I N I O N     A N D     F I N D I N G S

On February 9, 2022, Doc Holiday Express Company, d/b/a Holiday Express ("Applicant"), Grand Island, Nebraska, filed an application seeking to extend its authority as a common carrier in Nebraska intrastate commerce by adding the transportation of passengers in limousine and special party service between all points in Nebraska over irregular routes, and removing restrictions on its charter service. HHS Designation is no.

Notice of the Application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on February 16, 2022. On February 17, 2022 a timely protest was filed by VIP Limousine, LLC. On March 16, 2022 a timely protest was filed by Comstock Corporation d/b/a Action Cab.

On March 28, 2022, the Hearing Officer entered an Order which granted the Protests of VIP Limousine, LLC, and Comstock Corporation d/b/a/ Action Cab.

On June 16, 2022, Applicant submitted a written request to amend its application. Applicant stated that it would like to limit their operating authority to exclude providing service in Douglas, Sarpy, Cass, and Otoe counties.

After due consideration, I find that the Amendment submitted by Applicant should be granted.
