## BY THE HEARING OFFICER:

On March 1, 2022, Mighty Care Medical Transport, LLC ("Applicant") Omaha, filed an application seeking authority as a common carrier to provide passenger transportation by sedan and van in open class service between points in Douglas, Sarpy, Dodge, and Lancaster counties, and between said counties, over irregular routes. HHS Designation is yes. Notice of the Application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on March 11, 2022.

On March 23, 2022, timely protests were filed by Camelot Transportation, Inc., and Triumph Transportation. Protests were granted on May 24, 2022.

On June 6, 2022, a telephonic planning conference was held to discuss procedural schedule and hearing dates. Jamie Reyes, Trevor Matulka, and Dillon Keiffer-Johnson appeared on behalf of the Commission, and the following persons participated via telephone: Perry Pirsch on behalf of the Applicant and Andy Pollock and Adam Kost on behalf of the Protestants.

As a result, of the planning conference an Order Adopting Procedural Schedule and Setting Hearing was promulgated by the Hearing Officer on June 22, 2022. This Order set the hearing on this matter to take place on August 8, 2022, at 9:00 a.m.

After the Order Adopting Procedural Schedule and Setting Hearing was promulgated, the Hearing Officer was made aware that the Commission has a conflict with the August 8, 2022 hearing date and on its own motion now seeks to set a new hearing date.
