On April 11, 2014, an application was filed by Airport Transportation Company, Omaha, Nebraska, seeking expand its authority in open class services and in limousine services.

Protests were timely filed by Golden Plains Transportation Services, Inc., d/b/a GPS Transportation, Lincoln, Nebraska, and by VIP Limousine, Omaha, through their attorney Jack Shultz.

A hearing in this matter was scheduled for December 17 and 18, 2014. A Motion to Continue was granted. A second prehearing conference was held on December 15, 2014, via telephone conference. The following persons were present at the conference: Tara Paulson, attorney for the Applicant; Jack Shultz, attorney for the protestants; and Mark Breiner, staff attorney.

A hearing was scheduled for February 11, 2015, at 9:00 in the Commission hearing Room. On February 10, 2015, the Applicant filed a Motion to Continue, which was granted. A third prehearing conference was held on February 11, 2015, via telephone conference. The following persons were present at the conference: Commissioner Tim Schram, Hearing Officer; Tara Paulson, attorney for the Applicant; Jack Shultz, attorney for the protestants; and Mark Breiner, staff attorney.
