OPINION AND FINDINGS

By application filed November 9, 1999, Brown's Crew Car of Wyoming, Inc., dba Armadillo Express, Cheyenne, Wyoming, hereinafter referred to as applicant, seeks approval to continue the employment of Roy Landis, Miles A. Costello, Milford D. Jones, Thomas W. Stewart, and George H. Weekly as vehicle operators. Commission Rule 010.01E3 of Chapter 3, Title 291 requires carriers employing operators age 71 or over to seek a waiver. All of the above named operators are over 71 and are seeking such a waiver. Applicant has provided a valid medical certificate, a statement of insurability from its insurance carrier, and a statement indicating a desire to continue the employment for each of the above named operators. The driving records for each of the operators seeking a waiver have been reviewed, are current, and do not contain any information which may disqualify them from driving.

The Commission finds that such approval for the age waiver should be granted and that pursuant to Rule 010.01E3 of Chapter 3, Title 291 the applicant be able to continue to employ the above named operators.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the application for waiver pursuant to Rule 010.01E3 of Chapter 3, Title 291 for operators Roy Landis, Miles A. Costello, Milford D. Jones, Thomas W. Stewart, and George H. Weekly, be, and it is hereby, granted.
