O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

On July 15, 1999, pursuant to an order of this Commission entered on December 1, 1998, Star Limousine, Inc. (Star), of Omaha, Nebraska, was issued a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to engage in the transportation of passengers in luxury type vehicles between points in Nebraska over irregular routes.

Operators engaging in the transportation of passengers by limousine are subject to the Commission's Motor Carrier Rules and Regulations, Neb. R. & Reg., Title 291, Chapter 3. Specifically, Rule 005.12 permits the Commission to inspect, at any time, any vehicle subject to its jurisdiction. In addition, Rule 010.01J grants the Commission the power to enter the premises of any limousine operator to investigate whether any Commission rule has been violated, including whether the operator maintains the proper records on file as required by Rules 010.01L and 005.02.

In the matter before us, Star has denied this Commission, on numerous occasions, our rightful opportunity to inspect its vehicles and to ensure that Star maintains proper records on file. Therefore, the Commission finds that Star should be ordered to show cause, on or before November 23, 1999, why its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity should not be revoked for noncompliance with the Commission's Rules and Regulations.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Star Limousine, Inc., be, and it is hereby, ordered to show cause, on or before November 23, 1999, why its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity should not be revoked.




