OPINION AND FINDINGS

By application filed October 6, 1997, Leo & Deta Lindahl dba City Cab & Transit Co., Grand Island, Nebraska, sought to extend the authority as a common carrier in Nebraska intrastate commerce in the transportation of passengers and their baggage by taxicab between points in Adams and Hall counties over irregular routes.

Notice of the application was published in the Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on October 7, 1997. Protests were filed by Brown's Crew Car of Wyoming on October 8, 1997, and by Beverly Denman dba 80 Taxi Line, Hastings, on November 3, 1997.

On November 12, 1997 applicant moved to dismiss its application.

The Commission finds that the application should be dismissed.
