OPINIONS AND FINDINGS

On August 24, 1999, O'Rourke & O'Rourke Buggy Rentals, Inc., dba J & M Limo, Kearney, Nebraska, hereinafter referred to as applicant, filed an application docketed as Application No. B-1262, Supplement 3.

The hearing in this matter was set for a date later to be determined on September 29, 1999, and no action has been taken since then by the applicant to proceed with the application. Since no action has been taken, the applicant should be ordered to show cause on or before May 18, 2000, why its application should not be dismissed for lack of prosecution.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that O'Rourke & O'Rourke Buggy Rentals, Inc., dba J & M Limo, Kearney, Nebraska, be, and it is hereby, ordered to show cause why its application should not be dismissed for lack of prosecution on or before May 18, 2000.
