OPINIONS AND FINDINGS

By application filed August 24, 1999, O'Rourke & O'Rourke Buggy Rentals, Inc., Kearney, Nebraska, hereinafter referred to as applicant, seeks a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to operate as a common carrier of passengers by motor vehicle as follows:

AUTHORITY SOUGHT

Transportation of passengers by limousine service between points in Nebraska over irregular routes. RESTRICTION: The transportation of railroad train crews and their baggage is not authorized.

Notice of the application was published in <u>The Daily Record</u>, Omaha, Nebraska, on August 25, 1999, pursuant to the rules of the Commission.

An order was entered on April 18, 2000, in which applicant was ordered to show cause on or before May 18, 2000, why its Application No. B-1262, Supplement 3, should not be dismissed for lack of prosecution. Applicant states that negotiations are continuing and requests a continuation of the show cause until July 17, 2000.
