## OPINION AND FINDINGS

By application filed April 2, 1997, Husker Cabs, Incorporated, Lincoln, hereinafter referred to as applicant, seeks approval of a change in control of the corporation arising out of the transfer of stock ownership in Certificate B-1273 to Michael A. Breiner.

In its application, applicant further requested that this Commission grant temporary approval to the applicant of a change in control of Husker Cabs, Incorporated by transfer of stock to applicant. Notice of such request for temporary authority was published in <a href="The Daily Record">The Daily Record</a>, Omaha, Nebraska, on April 4, 1997, pursuant to the rules and regulations of this Commission.

It appears that failure to grant temporary approval may result in destruction of or injury to such motor carrier property and the transfer of stock sought to be acquired, or interfere substantially with their future usefulness in the performance of adequate and continuous service to the public.

Such temporary approval should be granted for ninety (90) days from the effective date of this Order pursuant to 75-319, R.R.S. 1943, as amended.

## ORDER

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the application for approval of the change in control of Husker Cabs, Incorporated by transfer of stock to Michael A. Breiner be, and it is hereby, granted to the applicant for ninety (90) days from the effective date of this Order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that transportation service rendered under such temporary authority shall be subject to the provisions of 75-101 to 75-801, R.R.S. 1943, as amended, and to the rules, regulations and requirements of the Commission; such grant of temporary authority and the operations thereunder shall not be admissible in evidence to establish or prove present or future public convenience and necessity; and no renewal or extension of the period of ninety (90) days shall be granted.
