OPINION AND FINDINGS

By application filed with the Commission on April 18, 1989, Brian L. Mills dba Fantasy Limousine, Omaha, Nebraska, hereinafter referred to as applicant, was issued a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity in Application B-1277.

As of February 3, 2004, applicant is not in full compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations; to wit: No Form E insurance filing has been made.

After due consideration of the circumstances, the Commission finds that applicant should be ordered to show cause on or before March 3, 2004, why its certificate should not be revoked for its failure to comply with the Motor Carrier Rules of the Commission.
