On September 13, 2005, the Commission entered an Order revoking the authority held by Brian L. Mills dba Fantasy Limousine. On September 21, 2005, a Motion for Reconsideration was filed by Mr. Mills. After discussion with Commission staff, Mr. Mills waived the right to oral argument in this matter, and was granted leave to submit written remarks. A letter in support of the Motion for Reconsideration was received by the Commission on October 4, 2005.

The Commission has considered the written remarks filed by Mr. Mills. After reviewing the filed remarks, the Commission finds that no new evidence or errors of law were presented that would cause the Commission to grant the Motion.

After being duly advised in the premises, the Commission is of the opinion and finds the Motion for Rehearing filed on behalf of Mr. Brian Mills d/b/a Fantasy limousine should be overruled.
