OPINION AND FINDINGS

On August 29, 2000, the Commission entered an order requiring Executive Limousines by Foos, Inc., Scottsbluff, Nebraska, to show cause on or before September 29, 2000, why its intrastate registration should not be revoked for failure to keep a current Form E insurance filing on file with the Commission and to pay annual fees. Executive Limousines by Foos, Inc., complied with the terms and conditions of the order entered on August 29, 2000, by filing a new Form E insurance filing with the Commission on September 18, 2000, and paying annual fees.

After due consideration of the circumstances, the Commission is of the opinion that the order to show cause should be dismissed.




O R D E R
