OPINIONS AND FINDINGS

On November 21, 1989, Executive Limousines by Foos, Inc., Scottsbluff, Nebraska, hereinafter referred to as applicant, was issued a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity in Application B-1284. An order was entered, at applicant's request, on August 4, 1998, suspending applicant's certificate until July 1, 1999. Another order was entered, at applicant's request, on June 22, 1999, suspending applicant's certificate until July 1, 2000. Applicant was informed that its authority is no longer in suspension and that it must make full compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations.

As of August 29, 2000, applicant is still not in full compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations; to wit: No Form E insurance filing has been made and no annual fees have been paid.

After due consideration of the circumstances, the Commission finds that applicant should be ordered to show cause on or before September 29, 2000, why its certificate should not be revoked for its failure to comply with the Motor Carrier Rules of the Commission.

O R D E R

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED, by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Executive Limousines by Foos, Inc., of Scottsbluff, Nebraska, be, and it is hereby, ordered to show cause why its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity should not be revoked for failure to comply with Commission rules on or before September 29, 2000.
