BY THE COMMISSION:

It was brought to the Commission's attention that an order *nunc pro tunc* should be entered to correctly reflect the authority granted by the Commission in the Application of Neoteric, Inc. d/b/a Chief Bus Service. The Commission finds that the name change granted in the order entered December 15, 1999, is at variance with that agreed upon by the parties involved in that the Commission's order failed to show that the Applicant was merged into, and became a part of, Busco, Inc. d/b/a Arrow Stage Line.

FINDINGS AND OPINION

Being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that:

1. The order entered in Docket B-1299, Supplement No. 1, entered on December 15, 1999, should be corrected *nunc pro tunc*; and,
2. The authority granted in Docket B-1299 should read as follows:

"Service and Territory Authorized:

COMMON: Passengers and their baggage in charter and special party operations between points in Nebraska over irregular routes, except railroad train crews and their baggage. SUPP. 1. Passengers and their baggage, in buses, in charter and special party operations between points in Nebraska over irregular routes. RESTRICTION: Restricted against the transportation of railroad train crews and their baggage."






