OPINION AND FINDINGS

On October 1, 2002 the Commission entered an order requiring Terry E. Jones dba T.J.'s Limousine Service, Brownville, Nebraska, to show cause on or before November 1, 2002, why its intrastate registration should not be revoked for failure to file a current Form E insurance and for failure to pay the annual fees. Because carrier failed to respond as ordered, its intrastate registration should be revoked.

After due consideration of the circumstances, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the order to show cause should be sustained and the registration should be revoked.
