OPINION AND FINDINGS

By application filed October 10, 2008, applicant, Denver Coach, Inc., Scottsbluff, Nebraska, seeking approval to transfer the stock of Denver Coach, Inc., to Kevin Stocker.

Notice of the application in caption was published in The Daily Record on October 13, 2008, pursuant to the rules of the Commission.

Since no protest was filed, Application B-1343 was processed pursuant to Rule 018.03 of the rules of the Commission.

After due consideration of the evidence and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission is of the opinion and finds:

1. That applicant is fit, willing, and able to properly perform the service proposed and will be so qualified after the proposed change in membership is effected.
2. That the change in stock ownership resulting from the proposed transfer of stock is consistent with the public interest and does not unduly restrict competition.
3. That a change in member interest pursuant to a transfer to Kevin Stocker should be approved.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application B-1343 for approval to transfer the stock of Denver Coach, Inc., to Kevin Stocker in Certificate B-1343 be, and it is hereby approved.
