OPINION AND FINDINGS

It was brought to the Commission's attention that an order nunc pro tunc should be entered to correctly reflect the authority granted by the Commission in the application of Sandhills Limos, Inc. The Commission has reviewed the files and records of the Commission and finds that a portion of the authority granted in the order of July 18, 2000, is at variance with that agreed upon by the parties involved. The language in Supplement 2, Restriction 3 should read, "The governmentally financed transportation of clients of the Nebraska Department of Health and Human Services and/or of private contractors of the Nebraska Department of Health and Human Services, such as, but not limited to, FHC Options, Partners, and Curtis & Associates, and/or persons in the custody of the Nebraska Department of Corrections, in their capacity as such clients and/or persons in custody, is not authorized."

From the evidence adduced in these proceedings and being fully informed in the premises, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that:

- 1. The order entered herein on July 18, 2000, was corrected nunc pro tunc on August 22, 2000, and should be corrected again nunc pro tunc.
- 2. The authority should read as follows:

SUPPLEMENT 2 Passengers by limousine, luxury automobile and passenger van, between points in Boyd, Holt, Wheeler, Greeley, Howard, Boone, Knox, and Antelope Counties on the one hand, and, on the other hand, points in and east of Boyd, Holt, Wheeler, Greeley, Howard, Hall, Adams and Webster Counties over irregular routes. RESTRICTIONS: (1) The transportation of railroad train crews and their baggage is not authorized; (2) Transportation of passengers in vehicles other than sedan-style luxury limousines is not authorized; (3) The governmentally financed transportation of clients of the Nebraska Department of Health and Human Services and/or of private contractors of the Nebraska Department of Health and Human Services, such as, but not limited to, FHC Options, Partners, and Curtis & Associates, and/or persons in the custody of the Nebraska Department of Corrections, in their capacity as such clients and/or persons in custody, is not authorized.

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ORDER

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission, that its order entered herein July 18, 2000, be, and it is hereby, amended nunc pro tunc and that a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity be issued to Sandhills Limos, Inc., setting forth the authority in the foregoing findings. All of the other findings, conditions and orders set forth in the previous order shall remain in full force and effect.
