OPINION AND FINDINGS

By application filed with the Commission on May 25, 1994, Mid America Coaches, Inc., dba Heartland Coaches, Beatrice, Nebraska, hereinafter referred to as applicant, was issued a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity in Application B-1377. Applicant surrendered his plates and cab cards in May and said he would let us know whether he planned to remain in business or revoke the certificate. A letter was sent to applicant on June 16, 2011, requesting the status of his business and giving him until June 24, 2011, to notify us.

As of June 28, 2011, applicant has not replied to our inquiry. No current Form E is on file as of June 17, 2011.

After due consideration of the circumstances, the Commission finds that applicant should be ordered to show cause on or before July 8, 2011, why its certificate should not be revoked for its failure to comply with the Motor Carrier Rules of the Commission, and that a hearing on the matter should be scheduled for July 13, 2011.

O R D E R

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Mid America Coaches, Inc., dba Heartland Coaches, Beatrice, Nebraska, be, and it is hereby ordered to show cause why its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity should not be revoked for failure to comply with Commission rules on or before July 8, 2011, and a hearing is set for July 13, 2011, at 1:30 p.m. in the Commission Hearing Room, Lincoln.
