OPINIONS AND FINDINGS

On November 4, 1994, Roger B. Miller, dba Metropolitan Cabs-Handicabs, Sioux City, Iowa, hereinafter referred to as applicant, filed an application docketed as B-1383. The application was set to be handled by modified procedure March 7, 1995, with affidavits to be on file with the Commission no later than February 28, 1995.

In spite of several communications with applicant, the applicant failed to file affidavits as required by the Commission.

After due consideration of the circumstances, the Commission finds that applicant should be ordered to show cause on or before April 28, 1995, why its application should not be dismissed for lack of prosecution.
