OPINION AND FINDINGS

It was brought to the Commission's attention that an order nunc pro tunc should be entered to correctly reflect the authority granted by the Commission in the application of Karibu Enterprises Inc., dba RT Round Trip Transport. The Commission has reviewed the files and records of the Commission and finds that a portion of the authority granted in the order of January 7, 1997, is at variance with that agreed upon by the parties involved.

From the evidence adduced in these proceedings and being fully informed in the premises, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that:

1. The order entered herein on January 7, 1997, should be corrected nunc pro tunc.
2. The authority should read as follows:

SERVICE AND TERRITORY AUTHORIZED:

Transportation of passengers and their baggage by passenger vehicles, including buses, vans and sport utility vehicles, between points in Nebraska over irregular routes.

RESTRICTION: The transportation of railroad train crews and their baggage is not authorized.


O R D E R

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission, that its order entered herein January 7, 1997, be, and it is hereby, amended nunc pro tunc and that a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity be issued to Karibu Enterprises, Inc., dba Round Trip Transport setting forth the authority in the foregoing findings. All of the other findings, conditions and orders set forth in the previous order shall remain in full force and effect.


