OPINION AND FINDINGS

By application filed January 5, 2000, Daniel W. and Susan L. Sindt dba Kearney Cab Company, Kearney, Nebraska, hereinafter referred to as applicant, seeks approval to utilize one 1990 Ford Arrowstar minivan for use as a taxicab in applicant's passenger transportation service. Applicant presently seeks to initiate the use of said equipment on an experimental basis to determine its viability, worthiness, and acceptance by the passengers served.

The Commission finds that such approval should be granted and that Rule 011.01D of Chapter 3, Title 291 be waived to allow applicant to add the Ford Arrowstar Minivan to its fleet on an experimental, trial basis.

O R D E R




