## OPINION AND FINDINGS

On January 11, 2000, the Commission entered an order requiring Gerald L. Andre dba Taxicab Service of La Placita, Lexington, Nebraska, to show cause on or before February 11, 2000, why its intrastate registration should not be revoked for failure to keep a current Form E insurance filing on file with the Commission, and failure to pay annual fees. Because carrier failed to respond as ordered, its intrastate registration should be revoked.

After due consideration of the circumstances, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the order to show cause should be sustained and the registration should be revoked.
