OPINIONS AND FINDINGS

On April 1, 1996, Gerald L. Andre dba Taxicab Service of La Placita, Lexington, Nebraska, hereinafter referred to as applicant, was issued a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity in Application B-1403. An order was entered, at applicant's request, on September 1, 1998, suspending applicant's certificate until September 1, 1999. Another order was entered, at applicant's request, on September 8, 1999, suspending applicant's certificate until December 9, 1999. Applicant was informed that its authority is no longer in suspension and that it must make full compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations.

As of January 11, 2000, applicant is still not in full compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations; to wit: No Form E insurance filing has been made and no annual fees have been paid.

After due consideration of the circumstances, the Commission finds that applicant should be ordered to show cause on or before February 11, 2000, why its certificate should not be revoked for its failure to comply with the Motor Carrier Rules of the Commission.

ORDER

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED, by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Gerald L. Andre dba Taxicab Service of La Placita, Lexington, Nebraska, be, and it is hereby, ordered to show cause why its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity should not be revoked for failure to comply with Commission rules on or before February 11, 2000.
