OPINION AND FINDINGS

By application filed with the Commission on February 26, 1996, Sharon Culp dba Seward Limousine, Seward, Nebraska, hereinafter referred to as applicant, was issued a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity in Application B-1407. An order was entered, at applicant's request, on September 19, 2000, suspending applicant's certificate until October 1, 2001. A second suspension was approved on October 4, 2001, further suspending applicant's certificate until November 1, 2002. Applicant was informed that its authority is no longer in suspension and that it must make full compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations.

As of November 5, 2002, applicant is still not in full compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations; to wit: No Form E insurance filing has been made and no annual fees have been paid.

After due consideration of the circumstances, the Commission finds that applicant should be ordered to show cause on or before December 10, 2002, why its certificate should not be revoked for its failure to comply with the Motor Carrier Rules of the Commission.

O R D E R

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Sharon Culp dba Seward Limousine, Seward, Nebraska, be, and it is hereby ordered to show cause why its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity should not be revoked for failure to comply with Commission rules on or before December 10, 2002, and a hearing was set for December 10, 2002, at 3:00 p.m. in the Commission Hearing Room, Lincoln.
