OPINION AND FINDINGS

On August 15, 2000, the Commission entered an Order to Show Cause against Sharon Culp dba Seward Limousine, Seward, Nebraska, hereinafter referred to as applicant, in Application B-1407. Applicant was ordered to show cause on or before September 15, 2000, why its intrastate registration should not be revoked for failure to keep a current Form E insurance filing on file with the Commission. By application filed with the Commission on September 11, 2000, Applicant requested a suspension of the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity issued in Application B-1407 until October 1, 2001.

Upon due consideration of this request, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the request should be granted and the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity in Application B-1407 should be suspended until October 1, 2001.


O R D E R


