OPINION AND FINDINGS

On November 5, 2002, the Commission entered an order requiring Sharon Culp dba Seward Limousine, Seward, Nebraska, to show cause on or before December 10, 2002, why its intrastate registration should not be revoked for failure to keep a current Form E insurance filing on file and no annual fees paid. A hearing was set for December 10, 2002, at which Sharon Culp dba Seward Limousine did not appear. Because carrier failed to respond as ordered, its intrastate registration should be revoked.

After due consideration of the circumstances, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the order to show cause should be sustained and the registration should be revoked.

ORDER

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED, by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the order to show cause entered November 5, 2002, be, and it is hereby, sustained and Sharon Culp dba Seward Limousine intrastate registration be, and it is hereby revoked.
