OPINION AND FINDINGS

By application filed October 2, 2000, and supplemented by affidavit filed October 17, 2000, DonMark, Inc., dba Cornhusker Cab Company, Papillion, Nebraska, hereinafter referred to as applicant, seeks approval to utilize minivans for use as a taxicab in applicant's passenger transportation service. Applicant seeks the use of said equipment to augment its fleet and to provide a larger cab since cargo space in newer sedans has become smaller.

Through its application and affidavit, the applicant has made the requisite showing that a different vehicle will serve as well or better in accordance with Rule 11.01D, Chapter 3, Title 291. Therefore, this Commission finds that the applicant's request should be granted and applicant should be permitted to add minivans to its fleet.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE, ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the application for approval of the use of the minivans to augment the applicant's taxicab fleet is hereby granted.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Rule 011.01D, Chapter 3, Title 291 is hereby waived with respect to DonMark, Inc., dba Cornhusker Cab Company's application for approval to institute the use of minivans to complement its passenger transportation service.
