OPINION AND FINDINGS

On September 17, 1996, the Commission entered an order in the matter in caption in which it granted applicant authority as follows:

Transportation of passengers and their baggage by taxi between points in Douglas and Sarpy Counties, on the one hand, and, on the other hand, between points in Nebraska over irregular routes. RESTRICTION: The transportation of railroad train crews and their baggage is not authorized.

On September 27, 1996, the protestants filed a Motion for Rehearing and/or Reconsideration. Oral arguments on the motion were heard October 22, 1996. From the arguments presented and a review of the record, the Commission finds that there are no grounds for reopening the record made herein, nor should the order be modified.

O R D E R

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED, by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the Motion for Rehearing and/or Reconsideration be, and it is hereby overruled.
