OPINION AND FINDINGS

On October 2, 1996, Innovative Marketing, Inc., dba The "Big Red Bus", Lincoln, Nebraska, hereinafter referred to as applicant, was issued a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity in Application B-1418. An order was entered, at applicant's request, on March 14, 2000, suspending applicant's certificate until March 14, 2001. Another order was entered, at applicant's request, on May 23, 2001, suspending applicant's certificate until March 14, 2002. Applicant was informed that its suspension of its authority would expire March 14, 2002, and it must make full compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations.

As of March 19, 2002, applicant is still not in full compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations; to wit: No Form E insurance filing has been made and no annual fees have been paid.

After due consideration of the circumstances, the Commission finds that applicant should be ordered to show cause on or before April 19, 2002, why its certificate should not be revoked for its failure to comply with the Motor Carrier Rules of the Commission.

O R D E R

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED, by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Innovative Marketing, Inc., dba The "Big Red Bus", Lincoln, Nebraska, be, and it is hereby, ordered to show cause why its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity should not be revoked for failure to comply with Commission rules or before April 19, 2002.


