OPINION AND FINDINGS

On June 6, 2000, the Commission entered an order requiring Donna M. Dunn dba Kiddie Cab, Lincoln, Nebraska, to show cause on or before July 6, 2000, why its intrastate registration should not be revoked for failure to keep a current Form E insurance filing on file with the Commission. Because carrier failed to respond as ordered, its intrastate registration should be revoked.

After due consideration of the circumstances, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the order to show cause should be sustained and the registration should be revoked.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the order to show cause entered July 11, 2000, be, and it is hereby, sustained and Donna M. Dunn dba Kiddie Cab's intrastate registration be, and it is hereby, revoked.
