OPINION AND FINDINGS

By application filed November 16, 1999, B. J. Z., Inc., dba Checker Cab, Norfolk, Nebraska, hereinafter referred to as applicant, seeks approval to continue the employment of Walter Pelc as a vehicle operator. Commission Rule 010.01E3 of Chapter 3, Title 291 requires carriers employing operators age 71 or over to seek a waiver. The above named operator is over 71 and is seeking such a waiver. Applicant has provided a valid medical certificate, a statement of insurability from its insurance carrier, and a statement indicating a desire to continue the employment of the above named operator. The driving record for the operator seeking a waiver has been reviewed, is current, and does not contain any information which may disqualify him from driving.

The Commission finds that such approval for the age waiver should be granted and that pursuant to Rule 010.01E3 of Chapter 3, Title 291 the applicant be able to continue to employ the above named operator.

ORDER

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the application for waiver pursuant to Rule 010.01E3 of Chapter 3, Title 291 for operator Walter Pelc, be, and it is hereby, granted.
