OPINION AND FINDINGS

By application filed May 27, 1997, Ambassador Limousine Service dba Teens N'Tots on Tires, Lincoln, Nebraska, hereinafter referred to as applicant, seek approval of the acquisition of the operating rights and authority granted to Teens N'Tots on Tires in Certificate B-1414, which authorizes:

SERVICE AND TERRITORY AUTHORIZED:

COMMON: Students, preschool through grade 12, and their baggage by passenger van, pursuant to arrangements and terms of a membership agreement, between points in Lancaster County over irregular routes. RESTRICTION: The transportation of railroad train crews and their baggage is not authorized.

In its application, applicant further requested that this Commission grant temporary approval to the applicant of a lease of the motor carrier properties and the certificate sought to be acquired by it. Notice of such request for temporary authority was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on May 28, 1997, pursuant to the rules and regulations of this Commission.

It appears that failure to grant temporary approval may result in destruction of or injury to such motor carrier property and the certificate sought to be acquired, or interfere substantially with their future usefulness in the performance of adequate and continuous service to the public.

Such temporary approval should be granted for ninety (90) days from the effective date of this Order pursuant to §75-319, R.R.S. 1943, as amended.

ORDER

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the application for approval of a lease of the motor carrier properties and the certificate sought to be acquired by Ambassador Limousine Service dba Teens N'Tots on Tires, it is hereby, granted to the applicant for ninety (90) days from the effective date of this Order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that transportation service rendered under such temporary authority shall be subject to the provisions of §75-101 to §75-801, R.R.S. 1943, as amended, and to the rules, regulations and requirements of the Commission; such grant of temporary authority and the operations thereunder shall not be admissible in evidence to establish or prove present or future public convenience and necessity; and no renewal or extension of the period of ninety (90) days shall be granted.
