OPINION AND FINDINGS

On October 14, 1999, the Commission entered an order requiring Ambassador Limousine Service dba Teens N' Tots on Tires, Lincoln, Nebraska, to show cause on or before October 29, 1999, why its intrastate registration should not be revoked for failure to keep a current Form E insurance filing on file and no annual fees paid. Because carrier failed to respond as ordered, its intrastate registration should be revoked.

After due consideration of the circumstances, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the order to show cause should be sustained and the registration should be revoked.

ORDER

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the order to show cause entered October 14, 1999, be, and it is hereby, sustained and Ambassador Limousine Service dba Teens N' Tots on Tires intrastate registration be, and it is hereby, revoked.
