OPINIONS AND FINDINGS

On August 26, 1999, the Commission received a Form K Insurance Cancellation Notice on Vintage Limousines, Inc., Aurora, Nebraska, who is a registered intrastate carrier with the Commission. Form K Insurance Cancellation Notice was received from Great Divide Insurance Company with a cancellation date of September 27, 1999. The carrier was notified by letter of the cancellation of its insurance and the carrier was also notified by Robert Logsdon, Motor Transportation Director, concerning the insurance filing. However, to date, the Commission has not received a current Form E insurance filing for Vintage Limousines, Inc.

After due consideration of the circumstances, the Commission finds that Vintage Limousines, Inc., should be ordered to show cause on or before December 21, 1999, why its intrastate registration should not be revoked for failure to keep a current Form E insurance filing on file with the Commission.

ORDER

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Vintage Limousines, Inc., Aurora, Nebraska, be, and it is hereby, ordered to show cause on or before December 21, 1999, why its intrastate registration should not be revoked for failure to keep a current Form E insurance filing on file with the Commission.
