OPINION AND FINDINGS

By application filed September 10, 1997, Theresa Corbino dba Service Forte, Omaha, Nebraska, sought authority as a common carrier in Nebraska intrastate commerce in the transportation of passengers by passenger vans, who require driver assistance to board and exit the vans, and their attendants, between points in Douglas and Sarpy Counties over irregular routes. RESTRICTION: The transportation of railroad train crews is not authorized.

Notice of the application was published in the Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on September 11, 1997. Protests were filed by Shared Mobility Coach on September 16, 1997, by Happy Cab Co. on September 24, 1997, by Metro Medical Transportation on October 2, 1997, and by Prince of the Road on October 9, 1997.

On October 20, 1997 applicant moved to dismiss its application.

The Commission finds that the application should be dismissed.

ORDER

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application B-1449 be, and it is hereby, dismissed.
