OPINION AND FINDINGS

On March 10, 1998, Ed Sheen dba Red River Limo Service, Minden, Nebraska, hereinafter referred to as applicant, was granted a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity in Application B-1459. On May 16, 2000, applicant was granted a suspension until May 16, 2001. On May 23, 2001, applicant was granted a further suspension until May 11, 2002. No further suspensions will be granted.

As of May 22, 2002, applicant is still not in full compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations; to wit: No Form E insurance filing has been made and no annual fees have been paid.

After due consideration of the circumstances, the Commission finds that applicant should be ordered to show cause on or before June 22, 2002, why its certificate should not be revoked for its failure to comply with the order entered on May 22, 2002, and Motor Carrier Rules of the Commission. The Commission also finds that a hearing should be set in this matter for July 2, 2002, at 2:30 p.m. in the Commission Hearing Room, Lincoln, Nebraska.

O R D E R

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED, by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Ed Sheen dba Red River Limo Service, Minden, Nebraska, be, and it is hereby, ordered to show cause why its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity should not be revoked for failure to comply with Commission order on or before June 22, 2002.

IT IS FURTHER, ORDERED, that a hearing should be set in this matter for July 2, 2002, at 2:30 p.m. in the Commission Hearing Room, Lincoln, Nebraska.




