OPINION AND FINDINGS

On May 22, 2002, the Commission entered an order requiring Ed Sheen dba Red River Limo Service, Minden, Nebraska, to show cause on or before June 22, 2002, why its intrastate registration should not be revoked for failure to keep a current Form E insurance filing on file and no annual fees paid. A hearing was set for July 2, 2002, at which Ed Sheen dba Red River Limo did not appear. Because carrier failed to respond as ordered, its intrastate registration should be revoked.

After due consideration of the circumstances, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the order to show cause should be sustained and the registration should be revoked.

O R D E R

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED, by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the order to show cause entered May 22, 2002, be, and it is hereby, sustained and Ed Sheen dba Red River Limo Service, intrastate registration be, and it is hereby revoked.
