## OPINION AND FINDINGS

By letter filed September 22, 2017, K.C. Services, LLC d/b/a Kiddie Cab ("Applicant"), Columbus, seeks an exemption from Nebraska statutes and Commission rules and regulations regarding common carriers pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. § 75-303(1) and cancellation of its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity granted in Docket No. B-1468. Applicant is authorized to provide prearranged transportation of passengers and their baggage, preschool through Grade 12, between points in Platte County and between points within said county, on the one hand, and, on the other hand, points in Nebraska over irregular routes. Applicant was granted its Certificate on May 20, 1998.

that it provides explained Applicant letter, from students to and for transportation services activities associated with their school curriculum during the school day. Applicant is paid for these transportation services by the school and school district. Applicant does not provide or solicit any for-hire transportation services to the general public.

Neb. Rev. Stat. § 75-303(1) exempts transportation by motor carrier for hire in the transportation of school children and teachers to and from school. In order to be granted an exemption under § 75-303, a carrier must provide only the transportation services that are the subject of the exemption.

Applicant submitted letters from the school explaining the special education curriculum, as well as a copy of an Individual Education Plan ("IEP"). The documentation notes that the school contracts with Applicant to provide transportation to job sites, community outings, and college programs associated with developing life skills for students with cognitive delays. The school also explained that mileage is paid to Applicant as part of the school budget billed to the school district. Applicant does not provide transportation to the general public, and only provides transportation to students from the school to the offsite location and back to school.

Based on the above, the Commission finds that K.C. Services, LLC d/b/a Kiddie Cab meets the qualifications to be a carrier exempt from Commission regulation pursuant to § 75-303(1). Therefore, Applicant's request to cancel its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity should be granted.

## ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the request by K.C. Services, LLC d/b/a Kiddie Cab, Columbus, for an exemption from Commission regulation be, and is hereby, granted.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity granted to K.C. Services, LLC d/b/a Kiddie Cab in Docket No. B-1468 be, and is hereby, cancelled.
