OPINION AND FINDINGS

On March 16, 2001, A-1 Ambassador Limousine, Inc., dba Ambassador Limousine, Lincoln, hereafter referred to as applicant, filed an application docketed as Application B-1469, Supplement 1.

On June 25, 2001, applicant filed a motion to dismiss the application. While we are completely aware of the underlying reasons for the applicant's present request, we note our concern as to the effect a dismissal may have on our proceeding where we propose to define limousine service and designate which carriers hold authority to transport clients of Health and Human Services. However, we are unaware of an occasion where we have refused an applicant's request to withdraw its application.

Therefore, after due consideration of the motion and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission is of the opinion and finds:

1. The motion should be granted.
2. Application B-1469, Supplement 1, should be dismissed.

O R D E R

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that applicant's motion to dismiss be, and it is hereby, granted.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Application B-1469, Supplement 1, be, and it is hereby, dismissed at applicant's request.
