By application filed August 20, 2001, A-1 Ambassador
Limousine, Inc., dba Ambassador Limousine, Lincoln, sought to

extend its authority as a common carrier of passengers and their baggage in Nebraska intrastate commerce as described in the caption above.

Notice of the application was published in the Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on August 27, 2001. Protests were filed by Midwest Special Services, Inc.; Prince of the Road; Yellow Cab & Limo, Inc.; Daniel and Susan Sindt, dba Kearney Cab Company; and Husker Cabs, Inc.

On February 27, 2002, the applicant moved to dismiss its application.
