O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

The Nebraska Public Service Commission (Commission) initiates this show cause proceeding on its own motion to enforce its interim policy set forth in Rule and Regulation No. 148 entered on April 3, 2001. After entering its interim policy and interpreting its rules with respect to Limousine Service and Open Class Service, A-1 Ambassador Limousine, Inc., d/b/a Haymarket Limousine (Haymarket Limousine) appealed the Commission's decision and the enforcement of the Commission's interim policy. On July 12, 2002, the Nebraska Supreme Court upheld the Commission's order and interim policy. In re Proposed Amend. to Title 291, 264 Neb. 298 (2002). The Commission received notice that the mandate had been issued by the Nebraska Supreme Court.

Upon information and belief, the Commission finds that as of November 19, 2002, Haymarket Limousine is still not in full compliance with the Commission's Order of April 3, 2001. Therefore, upon due consideration, the Commission initiates this proceeding to enforce its April 3, 2001 order. We find Haymarket Limousine should be ordered to immediately cease and desist providing transportation services in violation with the Commission's interim policy entered in Rule and Regulation No. 148.

We further find that Haymarket Limousine should be required to show cause on or before **December 9, 2002**, why this Commission should not revoke its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity or assess upon it any other penalty including administrative fines as it deems appropriate under Neb. Rev. Stat. § 75-156 (2000). A hearing on this Order to Show Cause will be set for **December 9, 2002**, at 10:00 a.m. in the Commission Hearing Room, Lincoln, Nebraska.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that A-1 Ambassador Limousine, Inc., d/b/a Haymarket Limousine, Lincoln, Nebraska, be, and it is hereby ordered to immediately cease and desist providing transportation services in conflict with the Commission's interim policy set forth in Rule and Regulation No. 148.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that A-1 Ambassador limousine, Inc., d/b/a Haymarket Limousine, Lincoln, Nebraska be required to show cause why its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity




