OPINION AND FINDINGS

By Order to Show Cause issued against A-1 Ambassador Limousine, Inc., d/b/a Haymarket Limousine, Inc. (Haymarket Limousine), of Lincoln, Nebraska entered on November 21, 2002, this Commission required Haymarket Limousine to demonstrate to the Commission why it should not be fined or why its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity should not be revoked for its failure to comply with the Commission's interim policy entered in Rule and Regulation No. 148. On November 26, 2002, the Commission partially granted A-1's application for open class authority and permitting it to transport clients of the Nebraska Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) and other The Commission now finds that the Show contractors thereof. Cause Order should be dismissed. The hearing scheduled with respect to the Show Cause should also be cancelled.
