O P I N I O N S A N D F I N D I N G S

On October, 3, 2000, this Commission entered an Order to Show Cause on applicant for failure to comply with the Commission's rules and regulations. In that Order, the Commission required the applicant to show cause why it has failed to obtain insurance coverage in compliance with Commission rules and regulations on or before November 3, 2000. At the Commission's public meeting on November 3, 2000, the applicant addressed the Commission and requested that it be given an additional 60 days to acquire the necessary insurance coverage. In support of the applicant's request, Steve Mason, the applicant's insurance agent, informed the Commission that he and the applicant had been in the process of working out the necessary paperwork for the insurance policy, however, he stated that the process had not yet been completed. He further stated that the applicant should have the necessary paperwork on file with the Commission in a matter of approximately thirty days.

Upon consideration of the applicant's request, the Commission has determined that it should give the applicant until December 8, 2000, which is thirty (30) days from the applicant's request, to provide the Commission with its Form E insurance filing and with payment of its annual fees. Consequently, the applicant is ordered to show cause on or before December 8, 2000, why its certificate should not be revoked for its failure to comply with the Motor Carrier Rules of the Commission.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE, ORDERED, by the Nebraska Public Service

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Commission that Security Transport Services, Lincoln, Nebraska, be and it is hereby, ordered to show cause why its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity should not be revoked for failure to comply with Commission rules on or before December 8, 2000.
