OPINIONS AND FINDINGS

On June 28, 1998, Security Transport Services, Omaha, Nebraska, hereinafter referred to as applicant, filed an application docketed as B-1478. An order was entered on December 1, 1998, granting applicant's application. A letter was sent to applicant on December 2, 1998, informing applicant of the requirements it must meet in order to be in full compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations. Full compliance was to be made on or before 60 days. An Order to Show Cause was entered on February 2, 1999. On March 2, 1999, the Order to Show Cause was sustained and the application dismissed. On March 30, 1999, the Motion for Reconsideration was granted, the Order to Show Cause Dismissed, and Application B-1478 and BR-222 were reinstated and granted as ordered. On June 22, 1999, applicant requested a suspension of his certificate from June 22, 1999, until January 1, 2000. On February 15, 2000, an Order to Show Cause was entered for failure to keep a current Form E insurance filing on file with the Commission. On March 21, 2000, the Order to Show Cause was dismissed and applicant requested a suspension of his certificate from March 21, 2000, to September 21, 2000. By certified letter dated September 13, 2000, and received September 22, 2000, applicant was informed that the suspension of its authority will end on September 21, 2000, and that it must be in full compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations.

As of October 3, 2000, applicant is still not in full compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations; to wit: No Form E insurance filing has been made and no annual fees have been paid.

After due consideration of the circumstances, the Commission finds that applicant should be ordered to show cause on or before November 3, 2000, why its certificate should not be revoked for its failure to comply with the Motor Carrier Rules of the Commission.

O R D E R

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED, by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Security Transport Services, Lincoln, Nebraska, be, and it is hereby, ordered to show cause why its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity should not be revoked for failure to comply with Commission rules on or before November 3, 2000.
