OPINIONS AND FINDINGS

On January 12, 2000, the Commission received a Form K Insurance Cancellation Notice on Security Transport Services, Omaha, Nebraska, who is a registered intrastate carrier with the Commission. The Form K Insurance Cancellation Notice was received from Columbia Insurance Company with a cancellation date of February 13, 2000. The carrier was notified by letter of the cancellation of its insurance and several attempts were made by Robert Logsdon, Motor Transportation Director, to notify the carrier also. However, to date, the Commission has not received a current Form E insurance filing for Security Transport Services.

After due consideration of the circumstances, the Commission finds that Security Transport Services should be ordered to show cause on or before March 15, 2000, why its intrastate registration should not be revoked for failure to keep a current Form E insurance filing on file with the Commission.

ORDER

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Security Transport Services, Omaha, Nebraska, be, and it is hereby, ordered to show cause on or before March 15, 2000, why its intrastate registration should not be revoked for failure to keep a current Form E insurance filing on file with the Commission.
