## OPINION AND FINDINGS

On February 15, 2000, the Commission entered an Order to Show Cause against Security Transport Services, Omaha, Nebraska, hereafter referred to as Applicant, in Application B-1478, as to why no action had been taken to proceed with the application. Applicant was ordered to show cause on or before March 15, 2000, as to why the application should not be dismissed for lack of prosecution.

On March 15, 2000, the Applicant filed a request for a six month suspension of the application. Accordingly, we find that the application should be suspended for a six month period, from March 21, 2000, to September 21, 2000.

## ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the Order to Show Cause be, and it is hereby, dismissed and Application B-1478 be, and it is hereby suspended until September 21, 2000.
